Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending April 24, a total of 193,209 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 203,896 people in the week ending April 17;

Alabama, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Missouri, and North Carolina saw increases in initial claims in the week ending April 24;

Nationally, 504,670 people filed claims during the week ending May 1, down from 612,060 in the week ending April 24.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending April 17, a total of 1,189,286 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 1,202,006 in the week ending April 10;

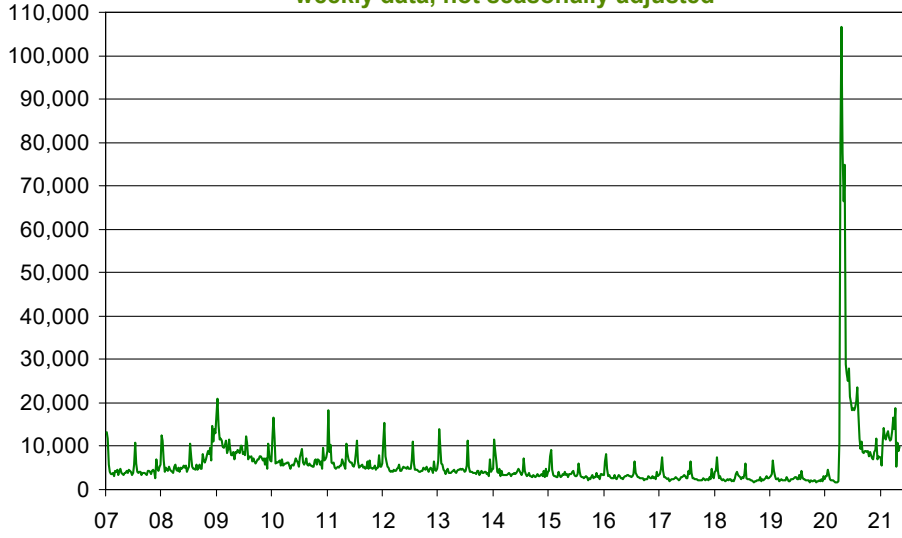
Arkansas, Florida, Indiana, Kentucky, Missouri, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending April 17;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.924 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.

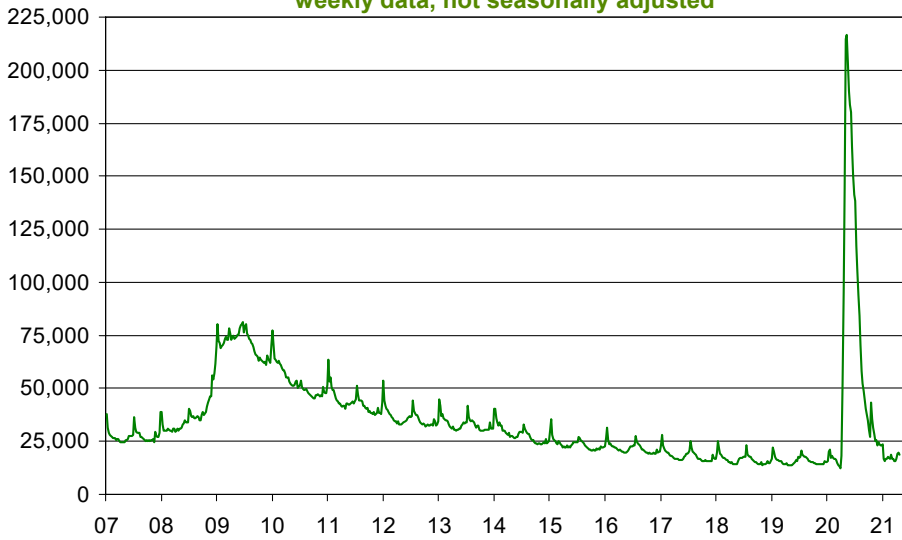

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



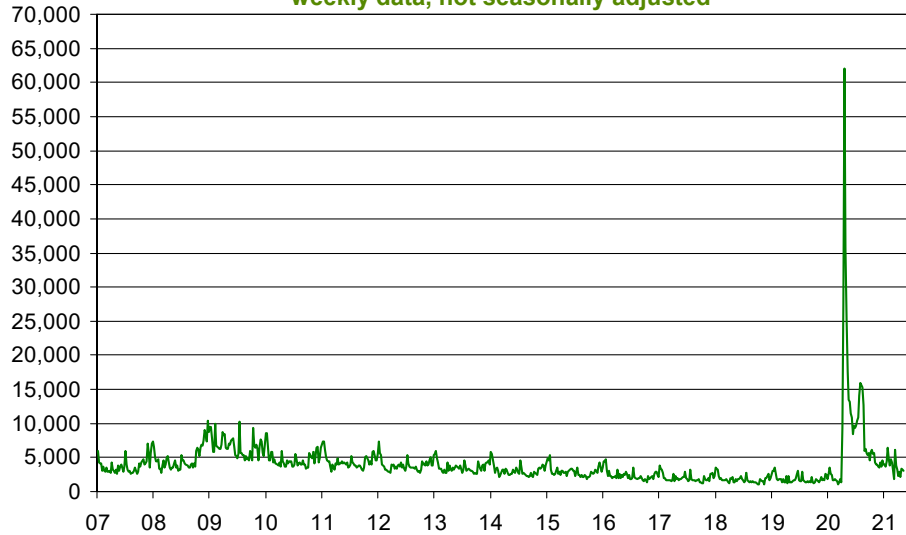

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



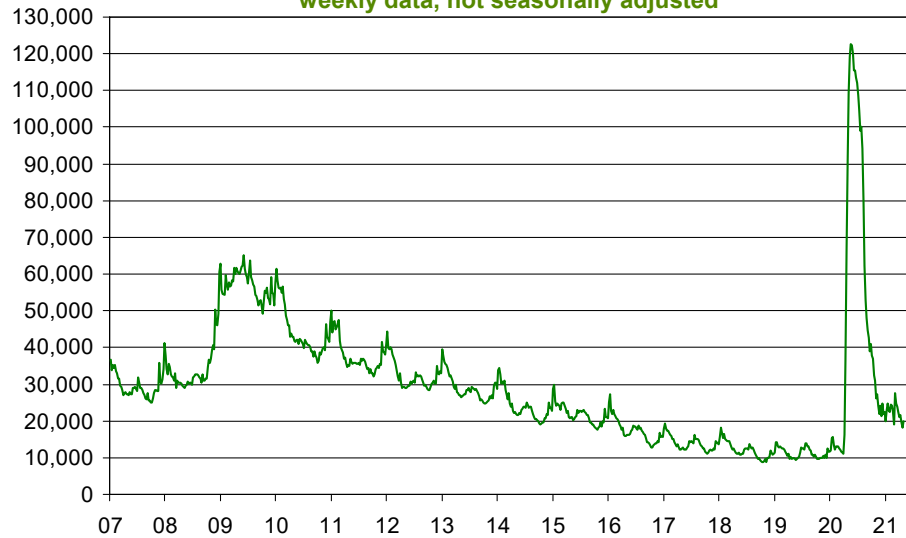

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



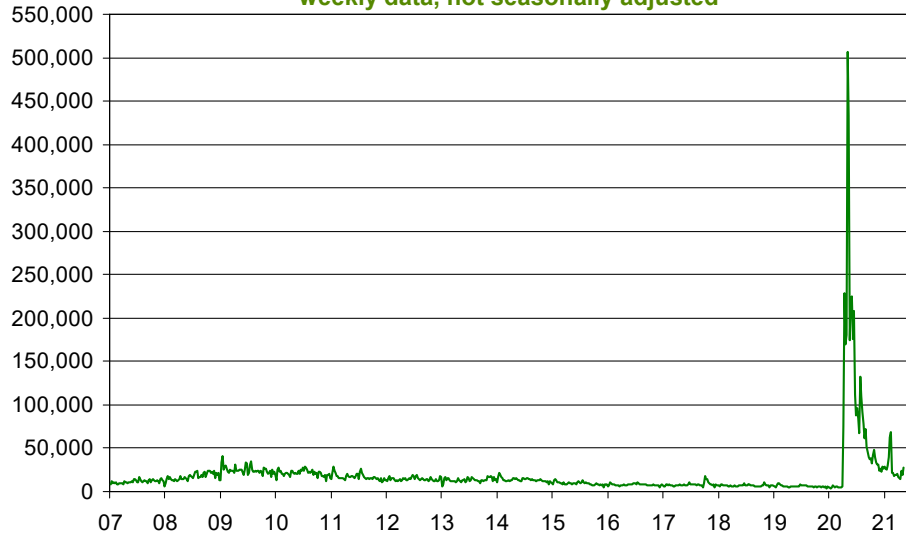

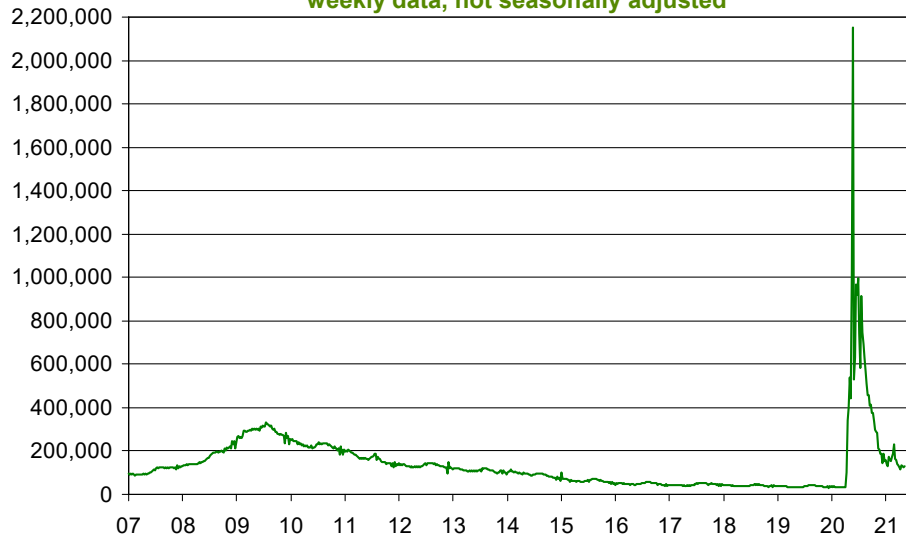

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

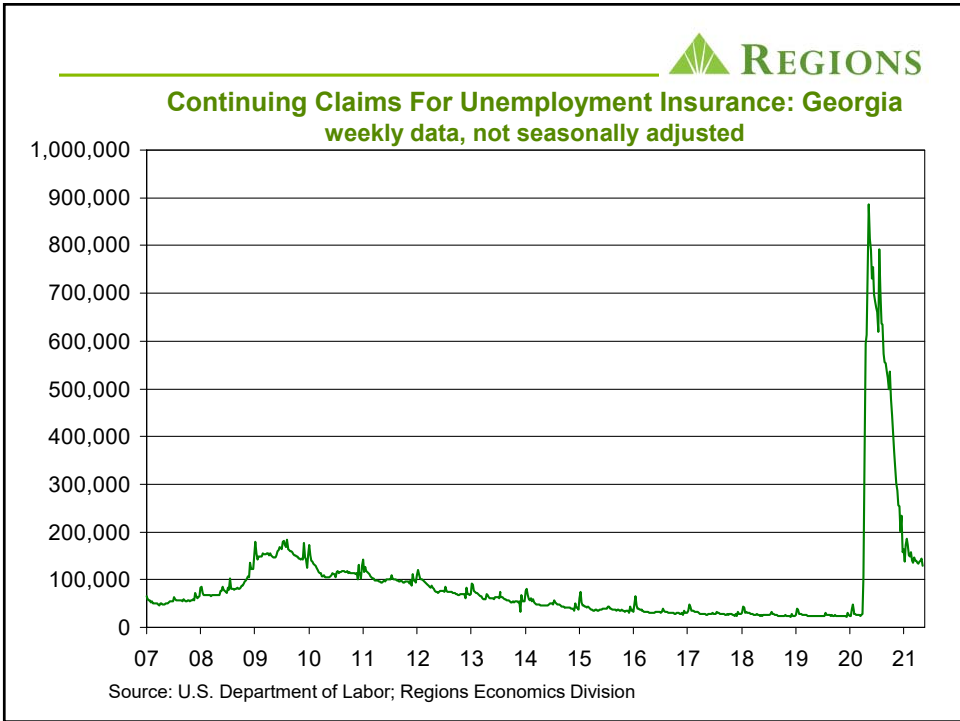
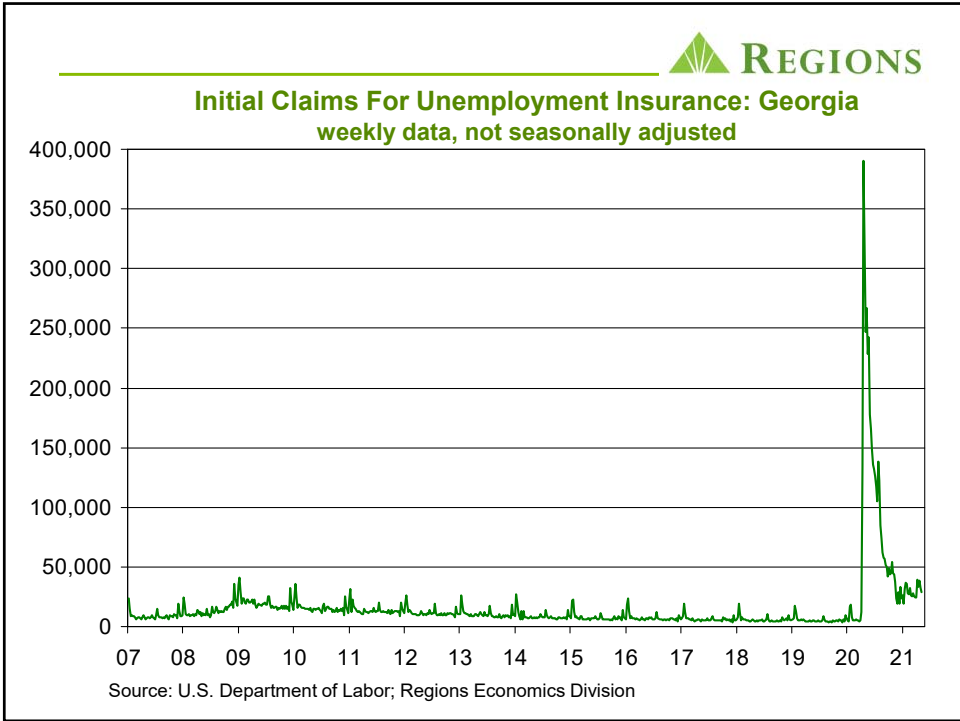

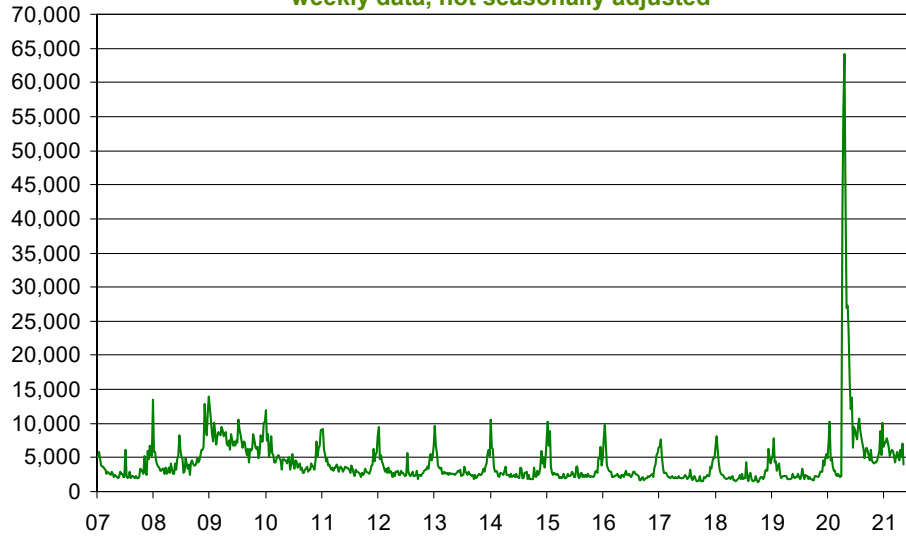
Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida

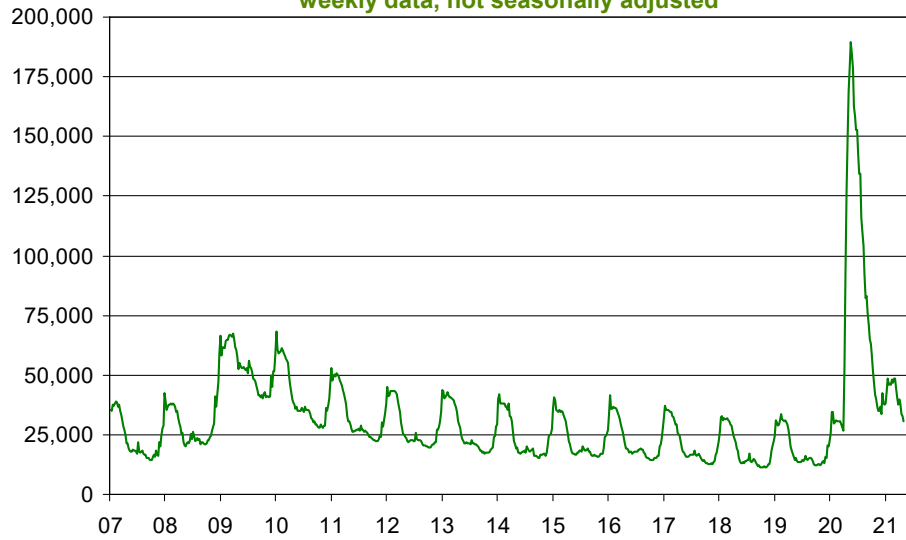


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



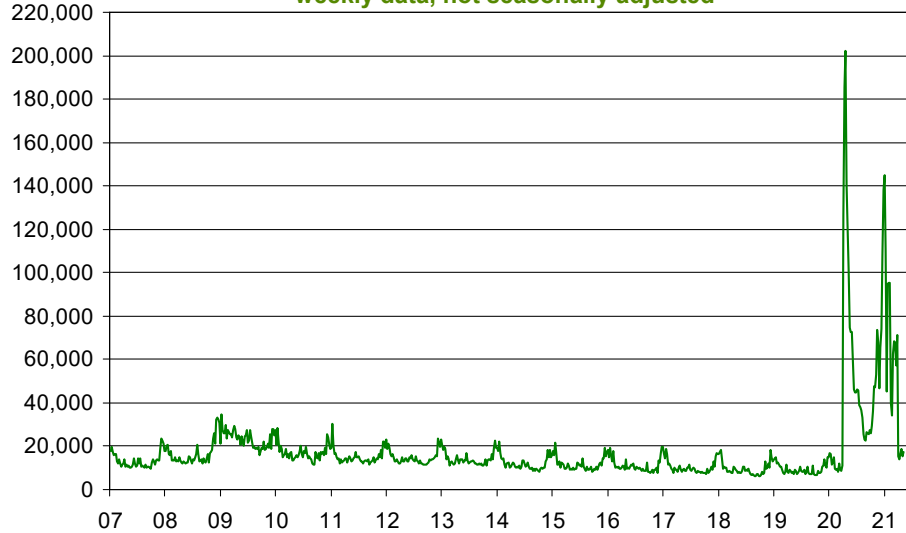

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



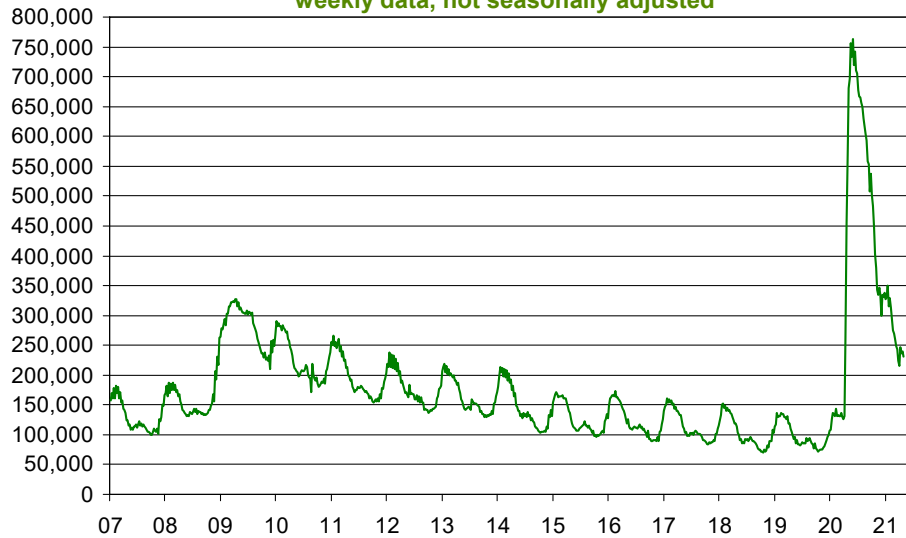

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



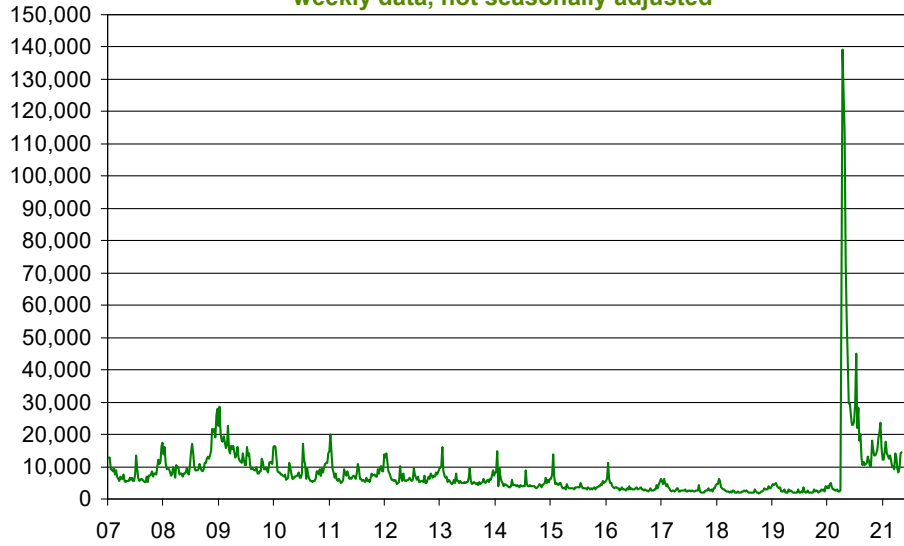

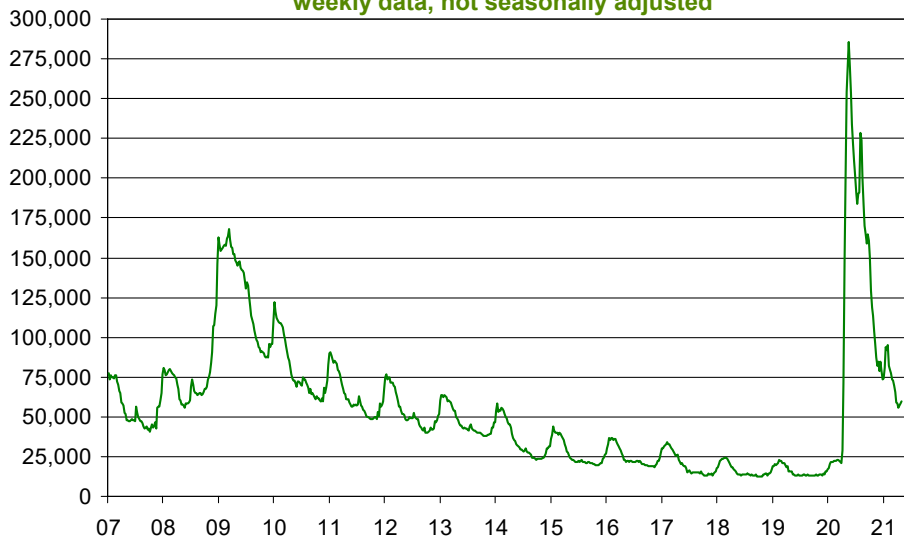

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



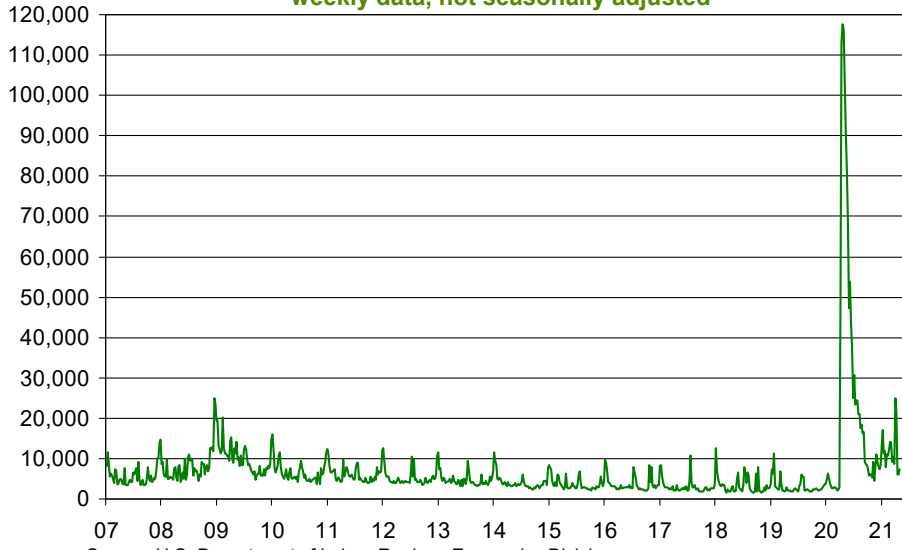

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



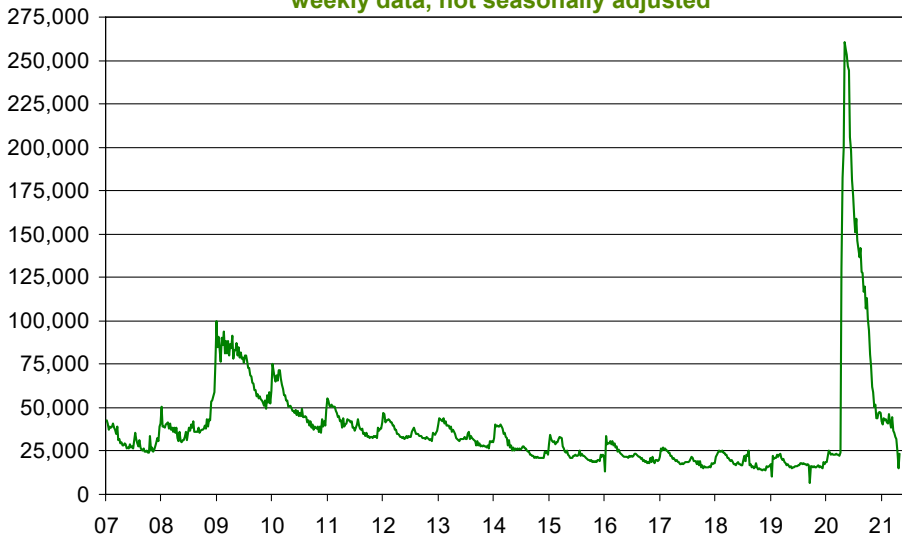

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



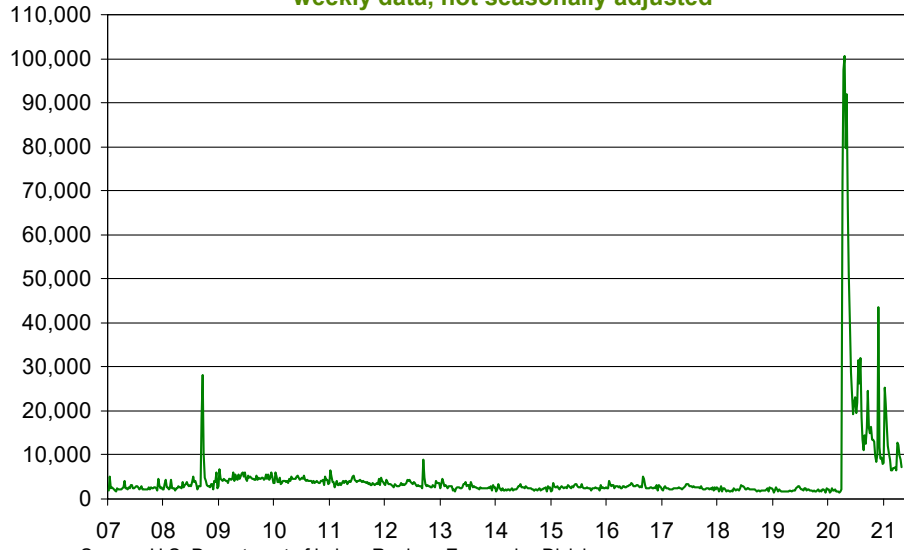

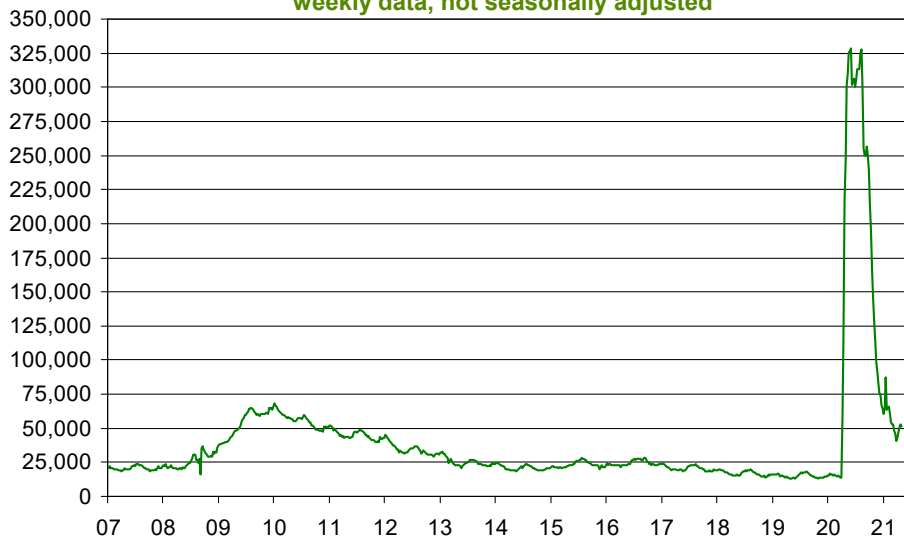

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



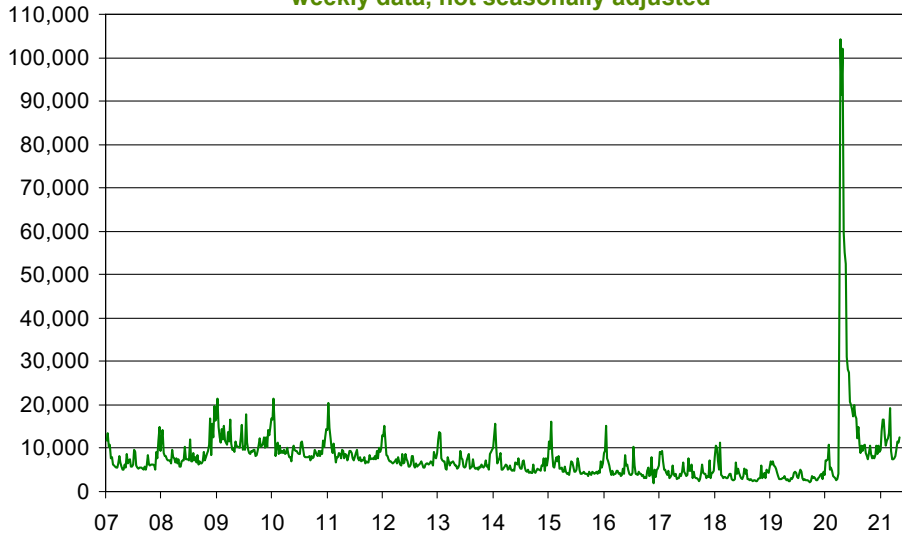

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



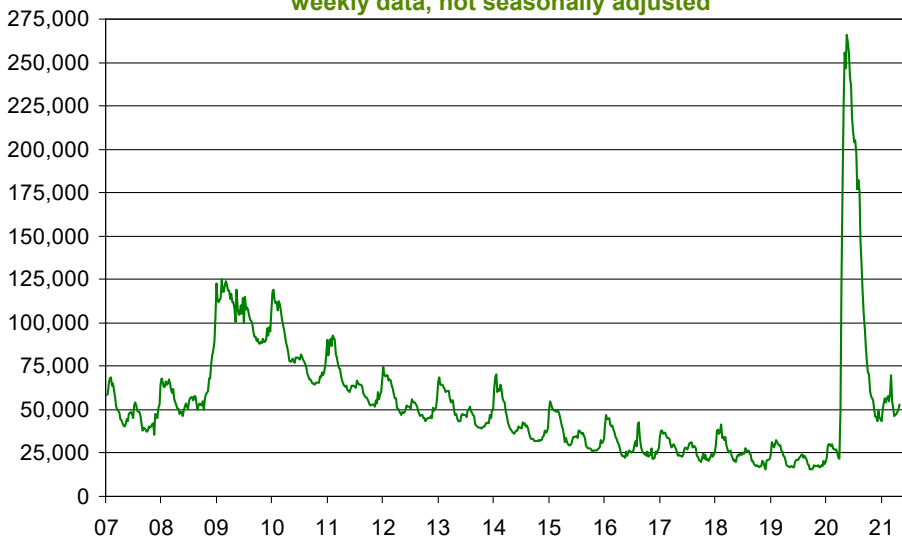

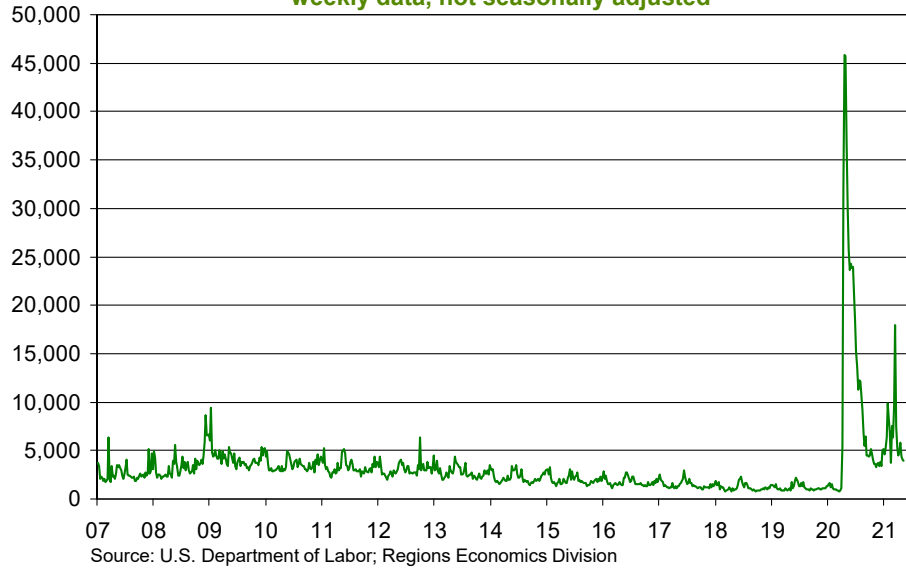

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

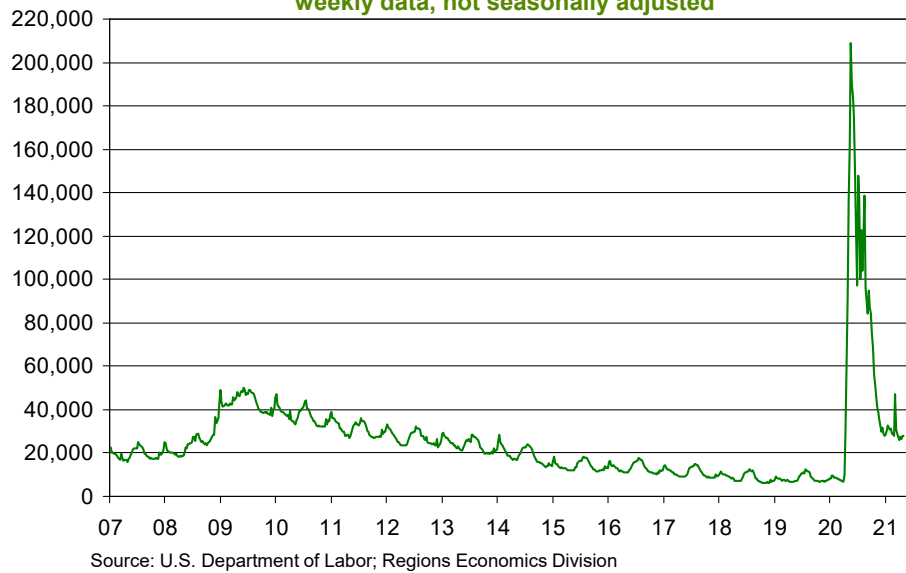

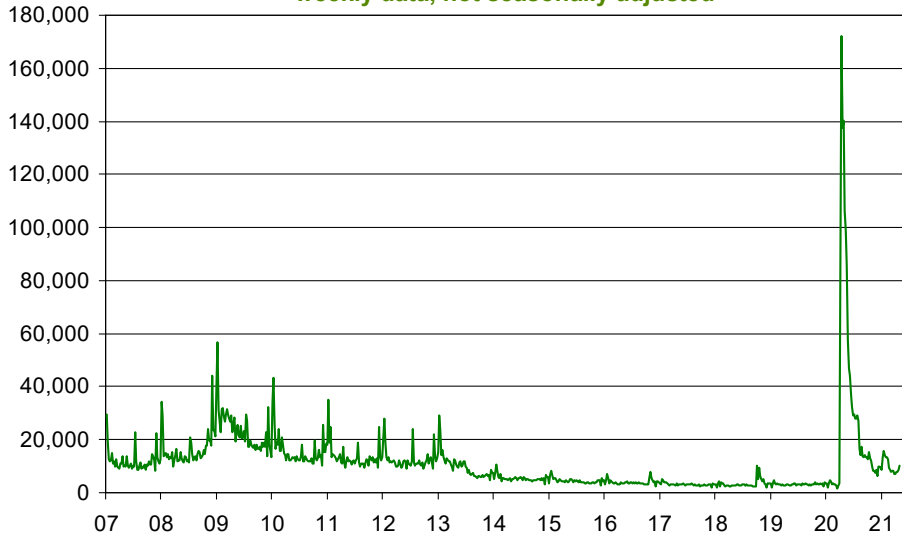
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi

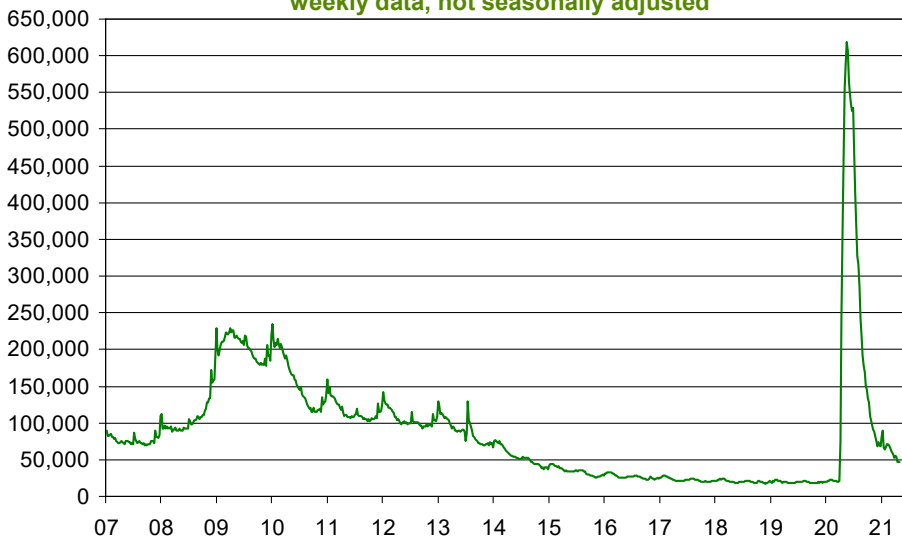


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



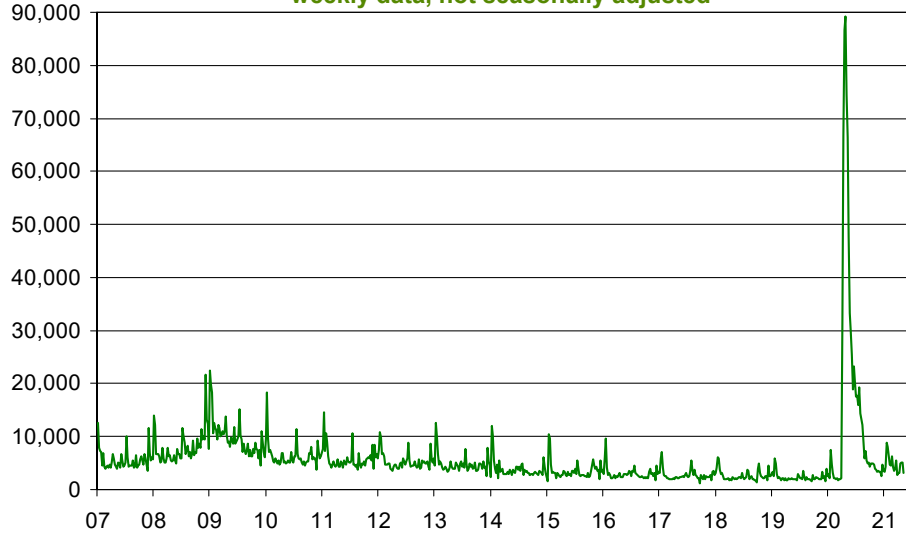

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



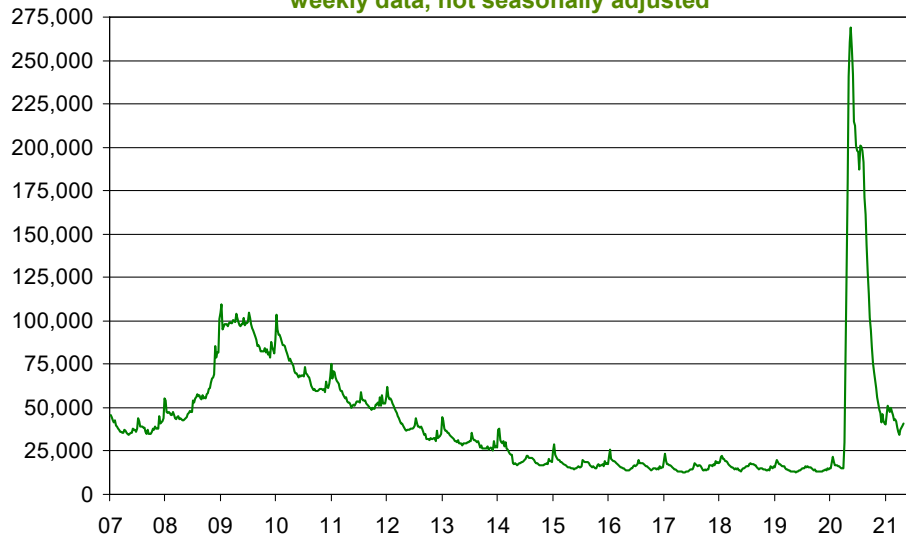

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



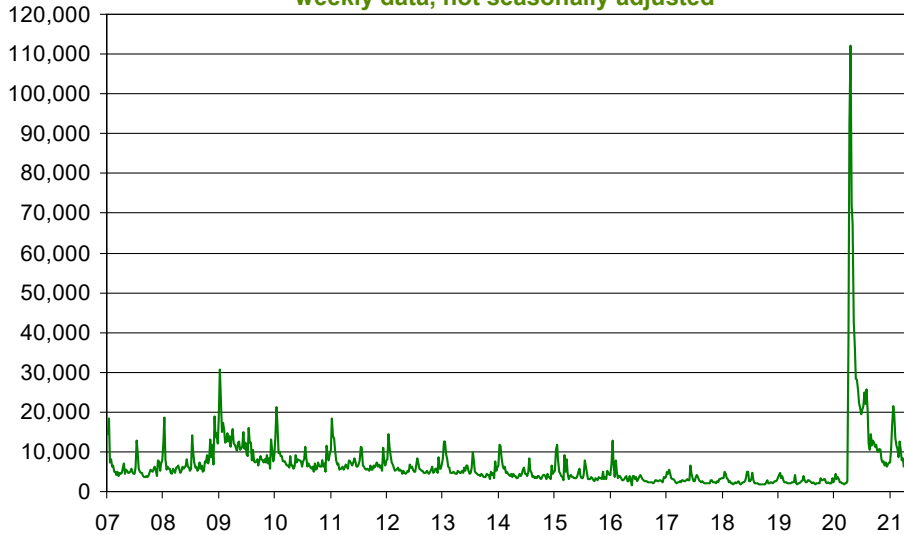

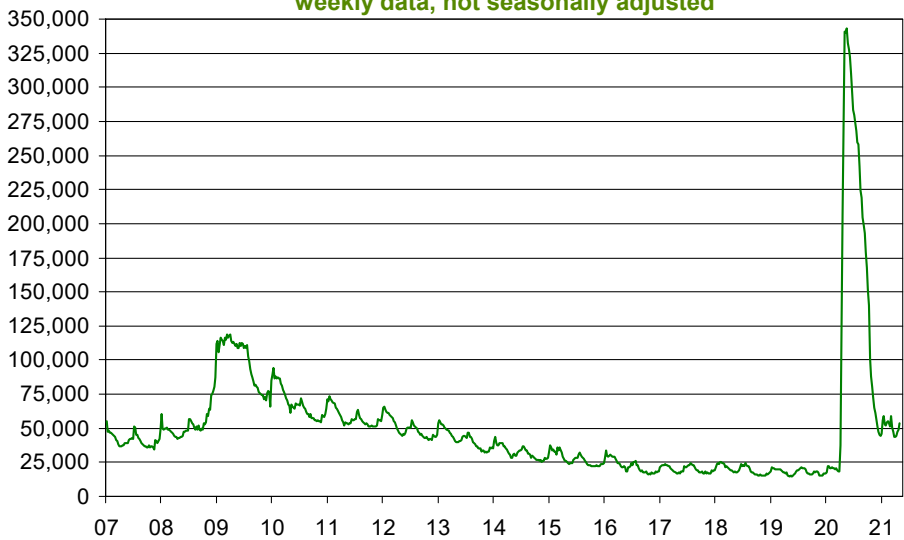

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



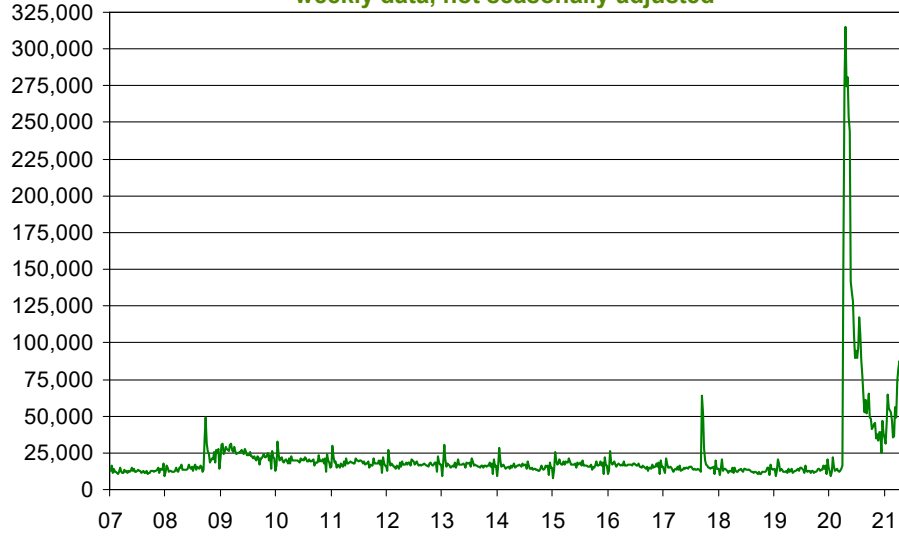

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



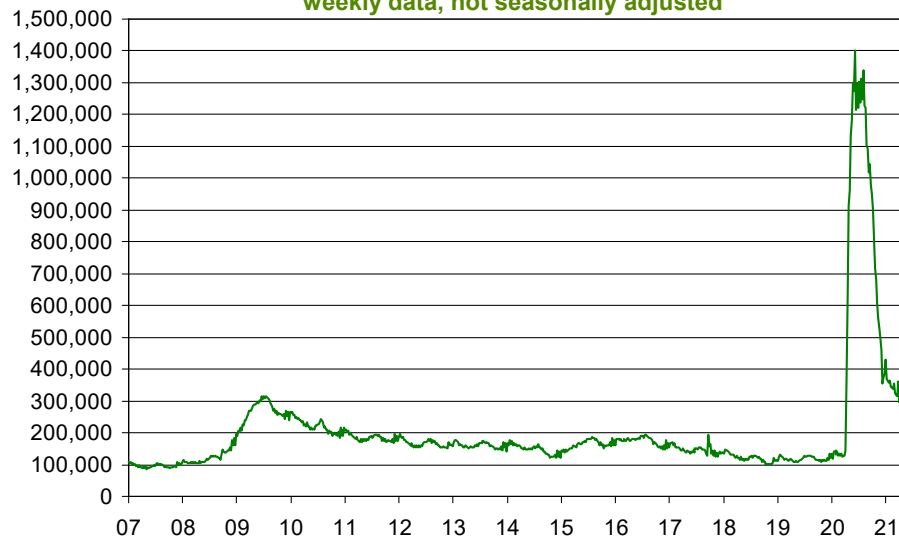

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



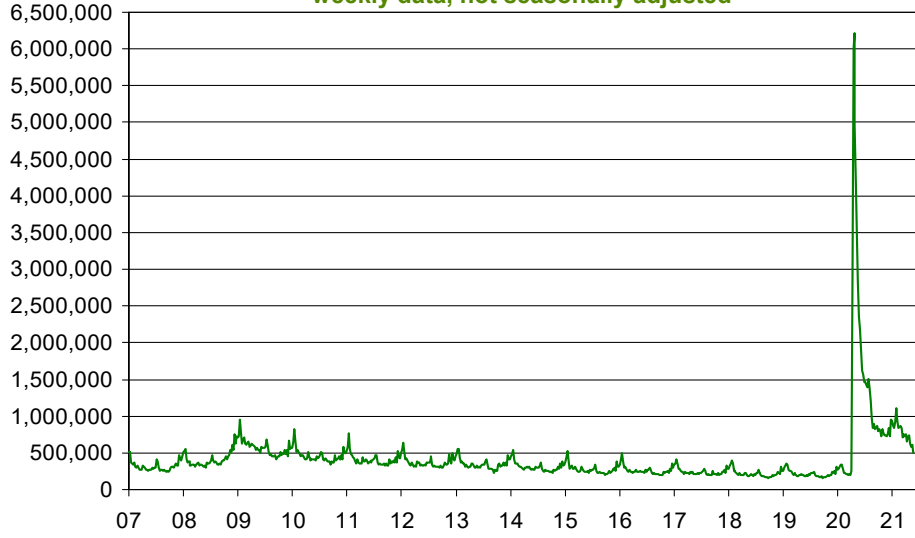

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



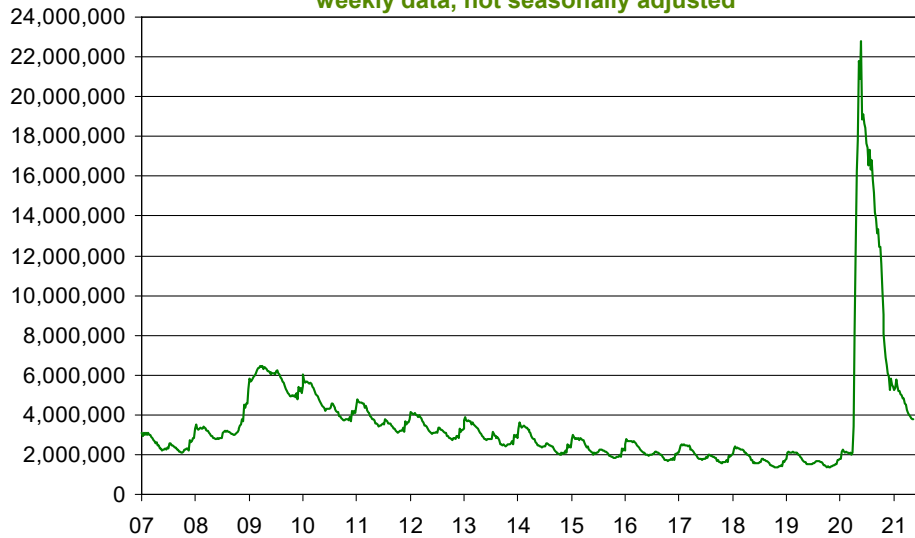
