Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending May 23, a total of 828,822 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 921,203 people in the week ending May 16, the fifth straight weekly decline in initial claims;

Over the most recent ten-week period, 14,164,914 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits;

Alabama, Iowa, and Kentucky saw higher initial claims in the week ending May 23;

Though initial claims are subsiding, the absolute numbers remain significantly elevated. Over the 52 weeks ending February 29, initial claims within the Regions footprint averaged 62,064 per week.

Continuing Claims:

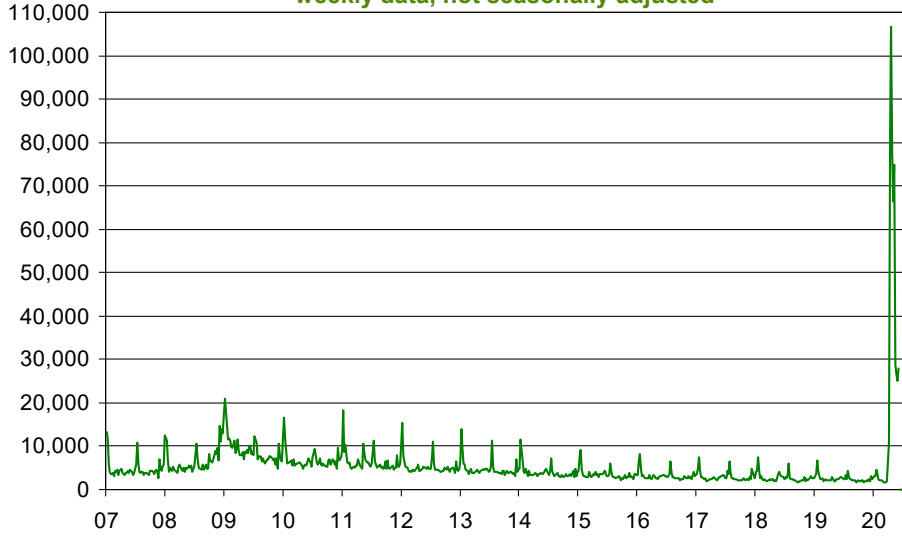
As of the week ending May 16, a total of 6,184,377 people within the Regions footprint were receiving Unemployment Insurance benefits;

At this point, the data for Florida should be considered little more than noise, with continuing claims falling by over 1.6 million in the latest week after having risen by over 1.1 million in the prior week;

Note that the regular data on initial and continuing claims do not incorporate claims filed under the Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation program, which is still not up and running in all 50 states.

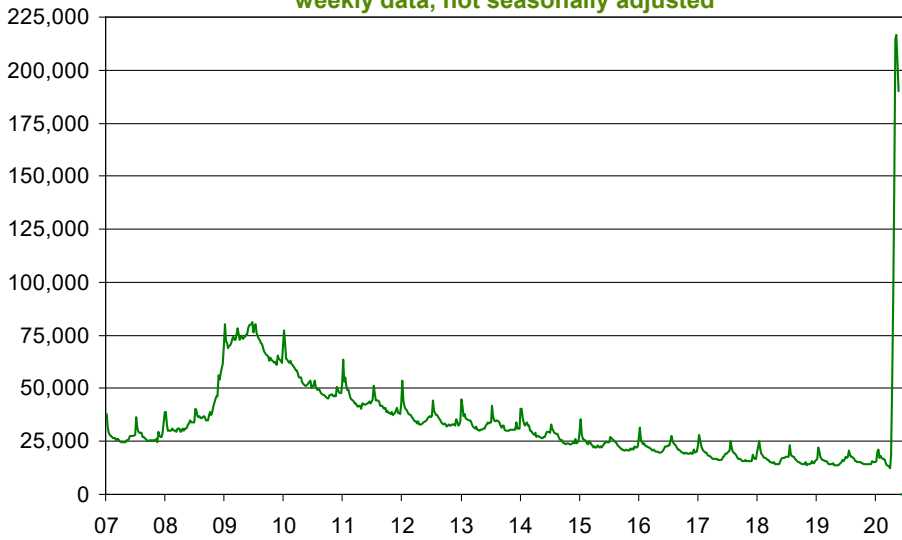

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



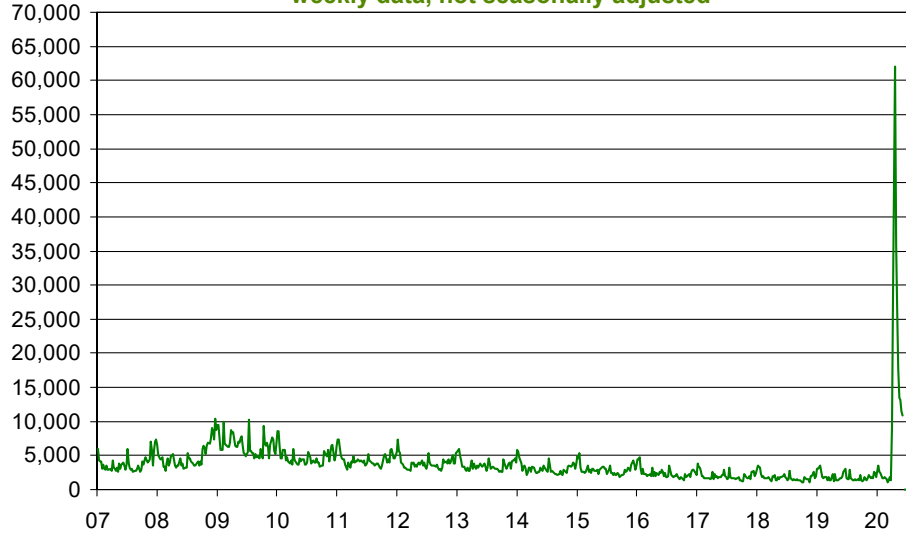

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



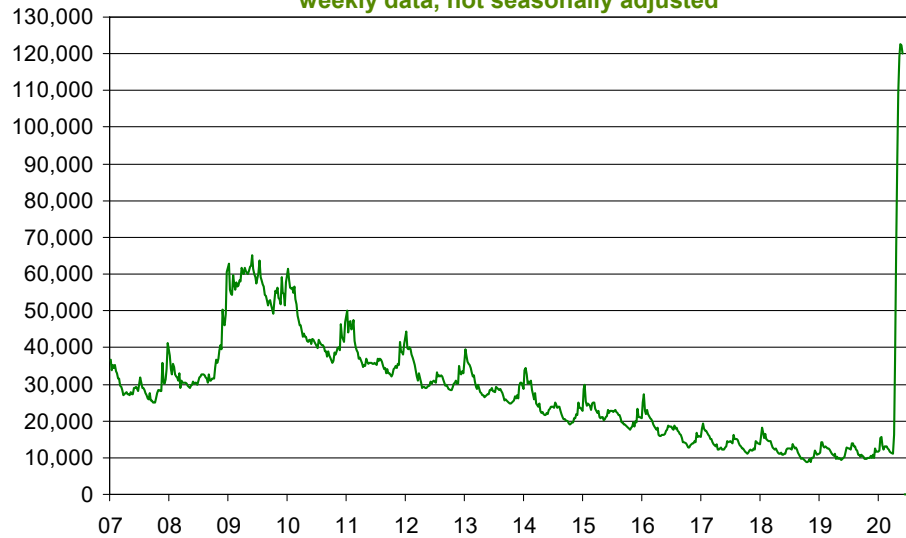

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



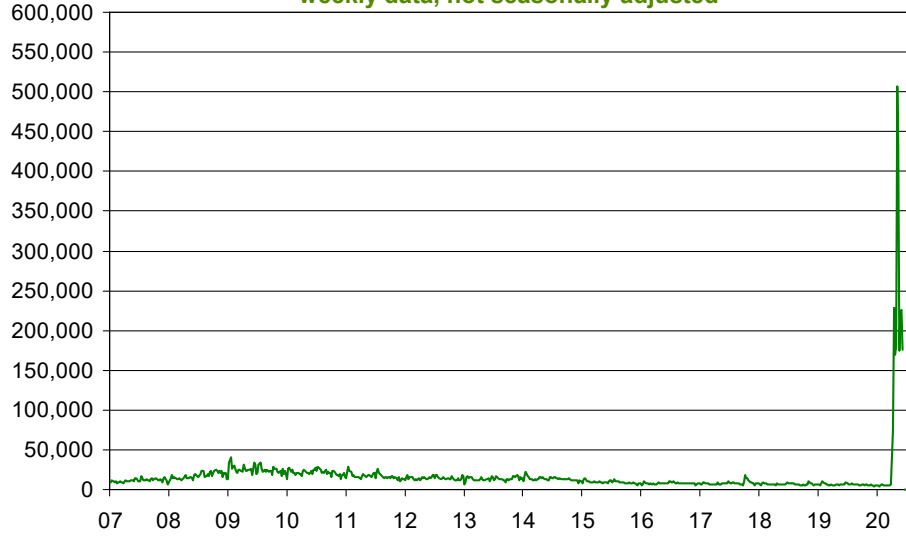

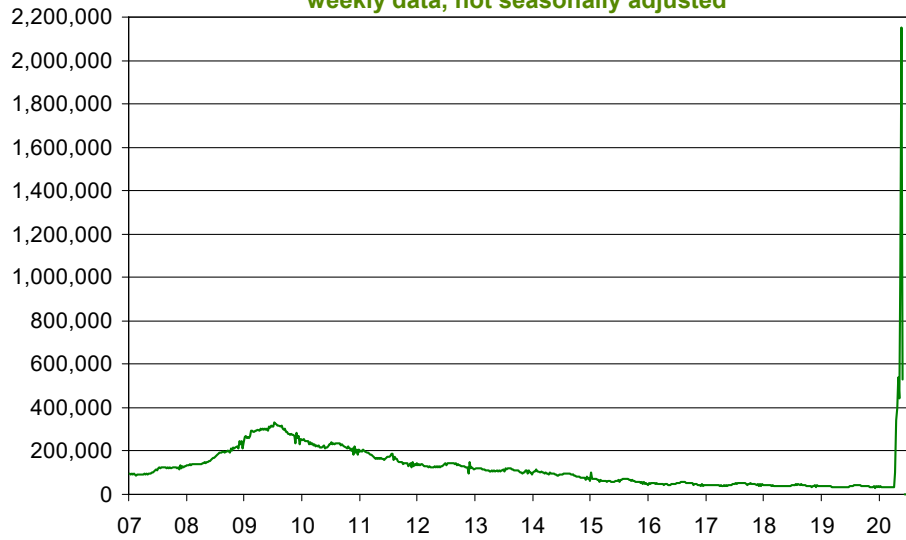

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

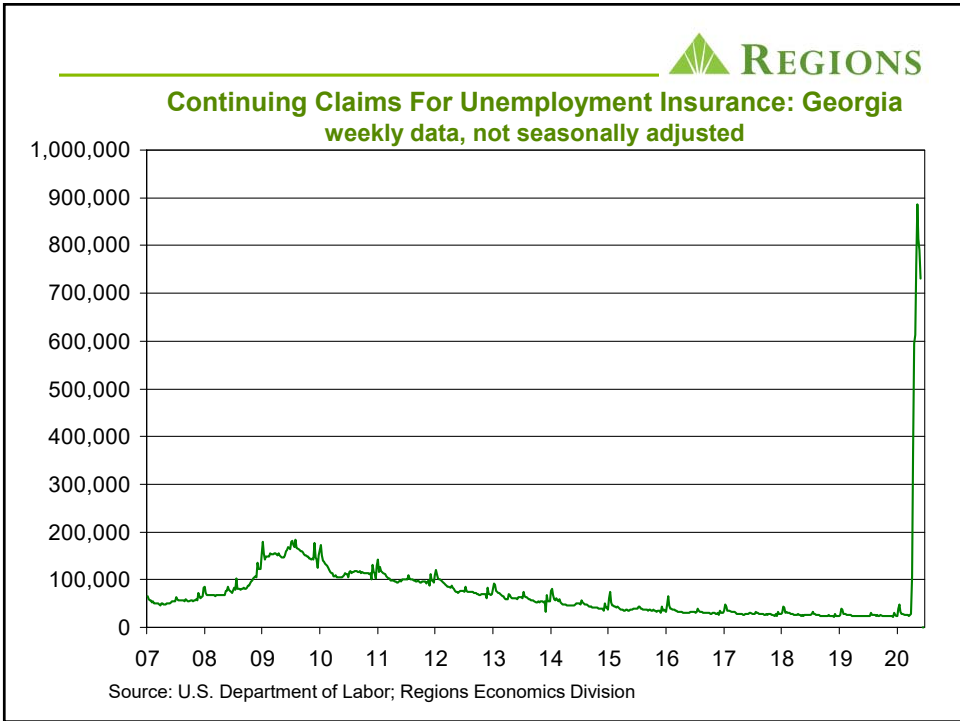
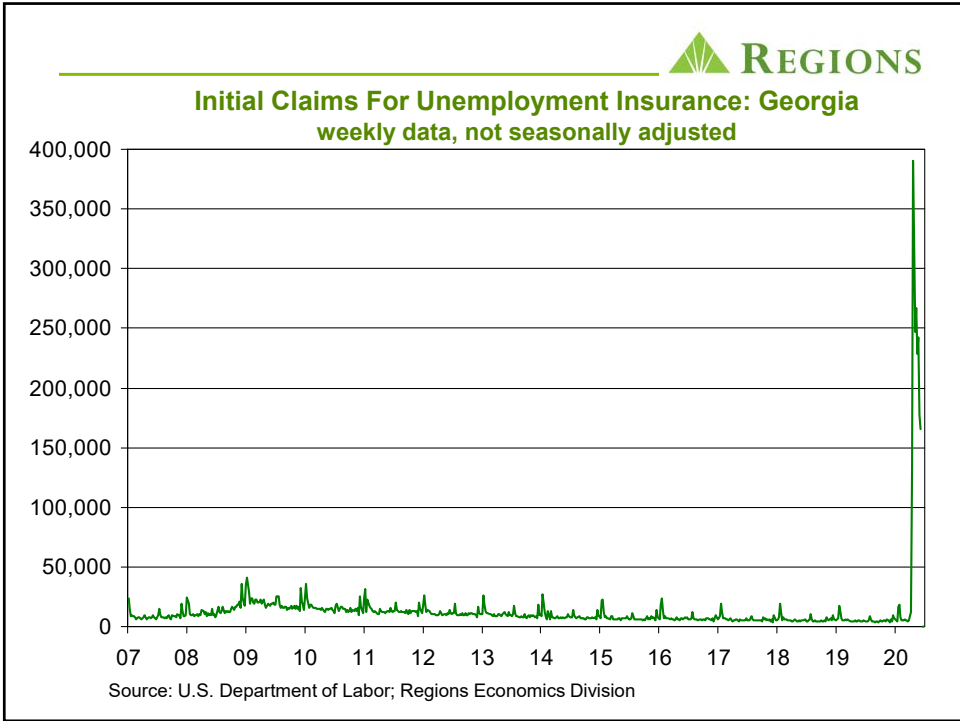

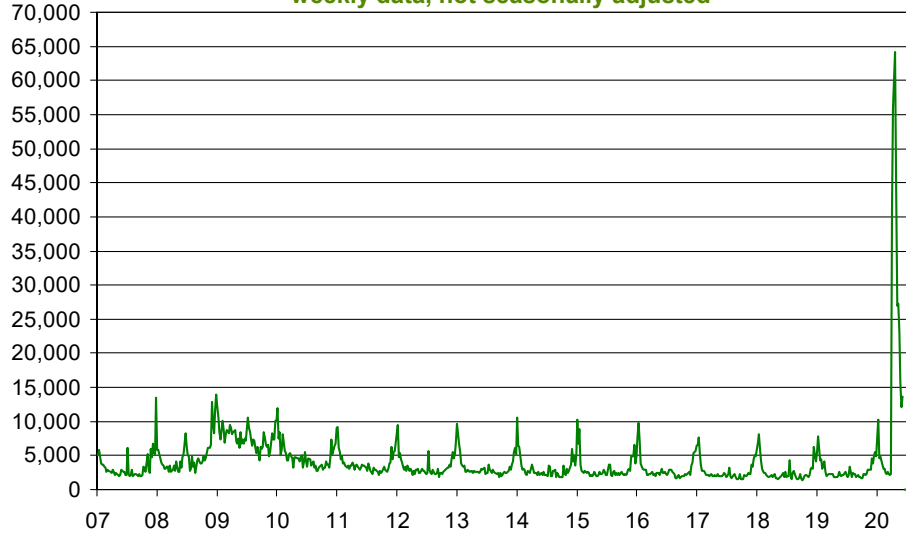
Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida

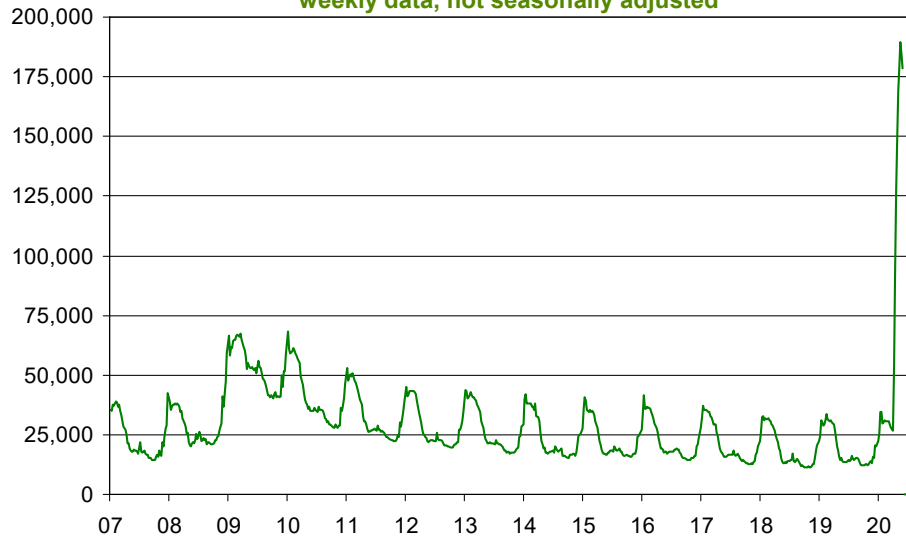


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



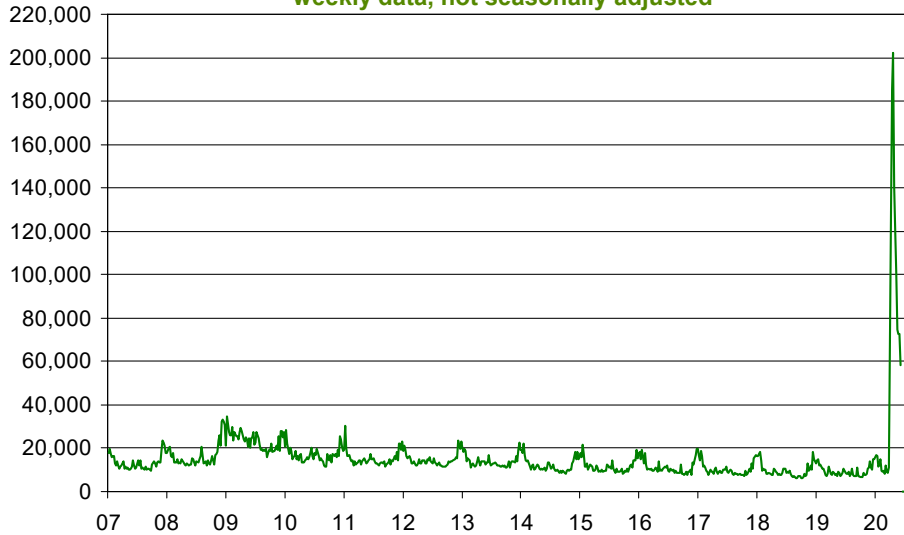

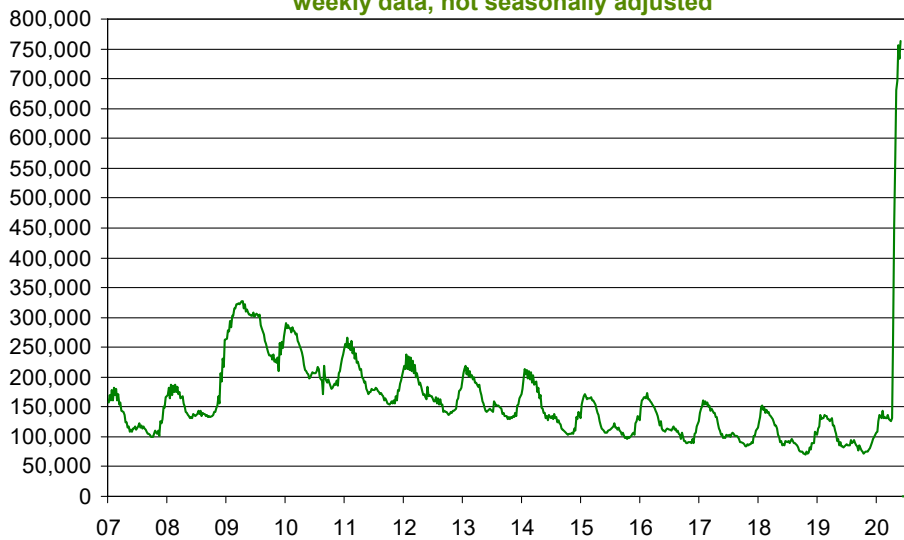

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



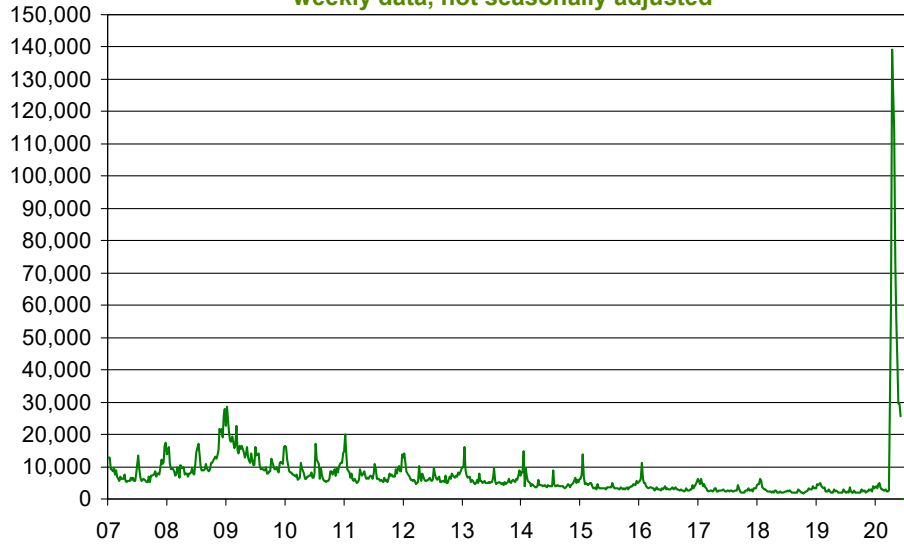

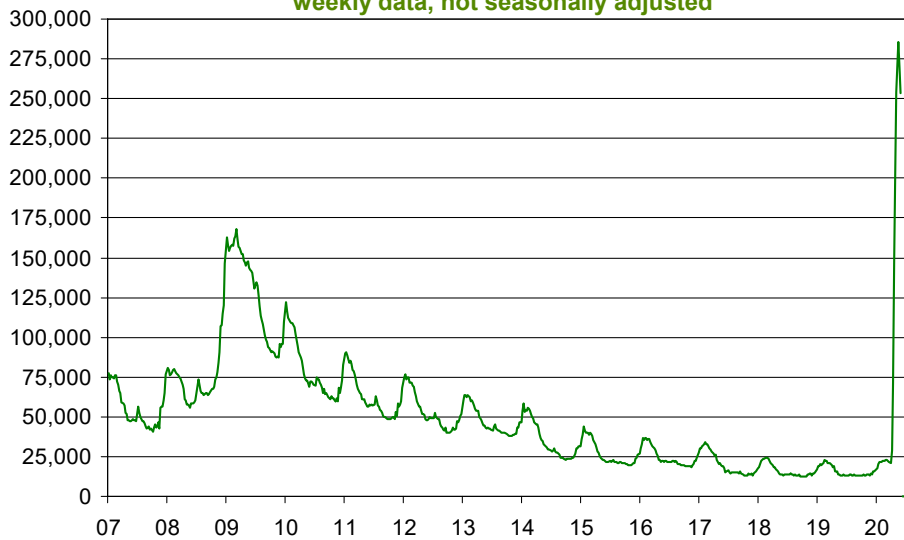

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



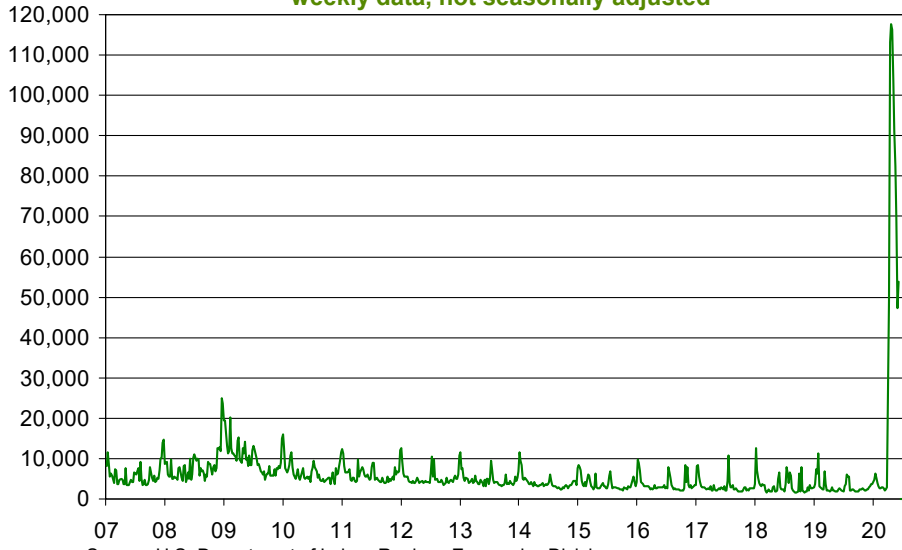

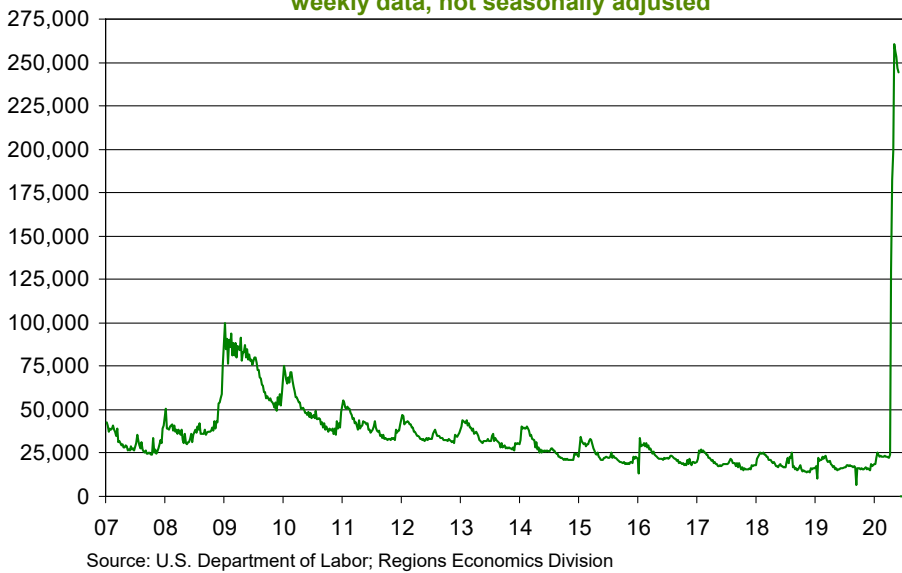

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

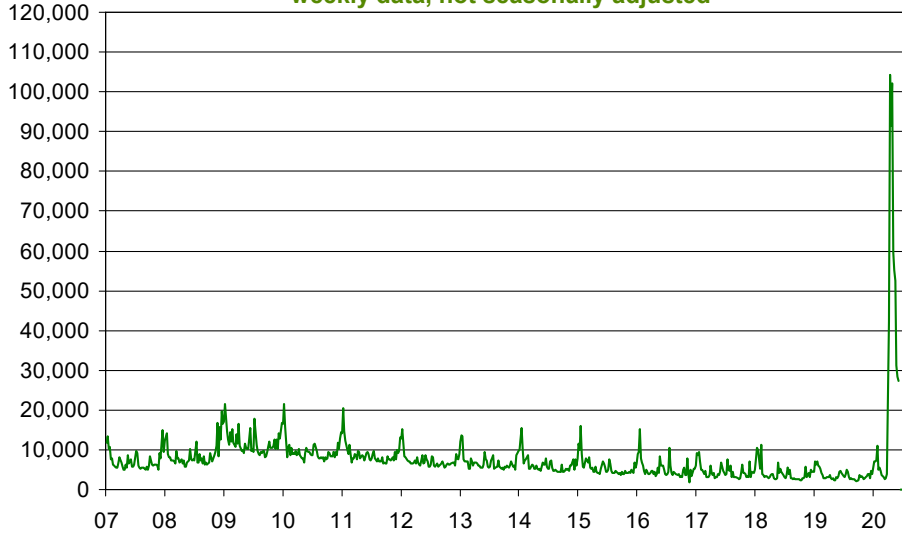


Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



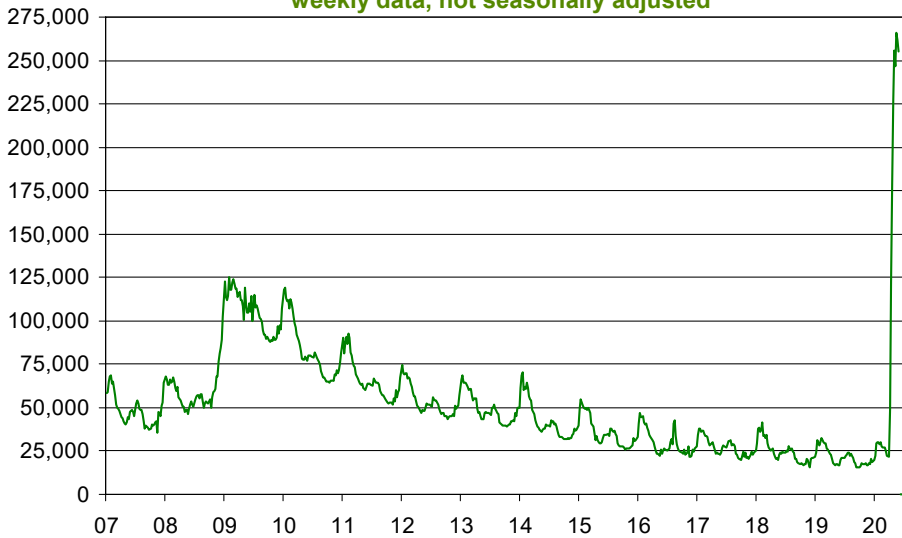


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



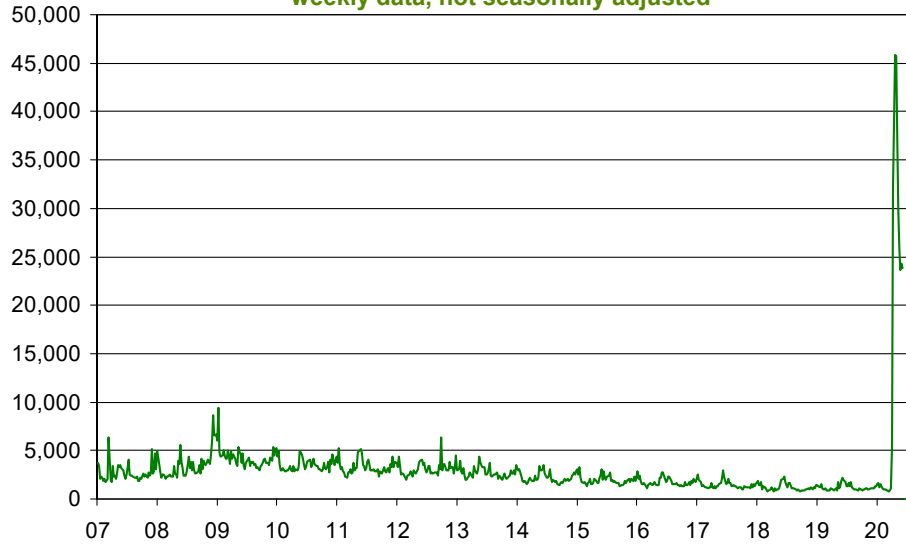

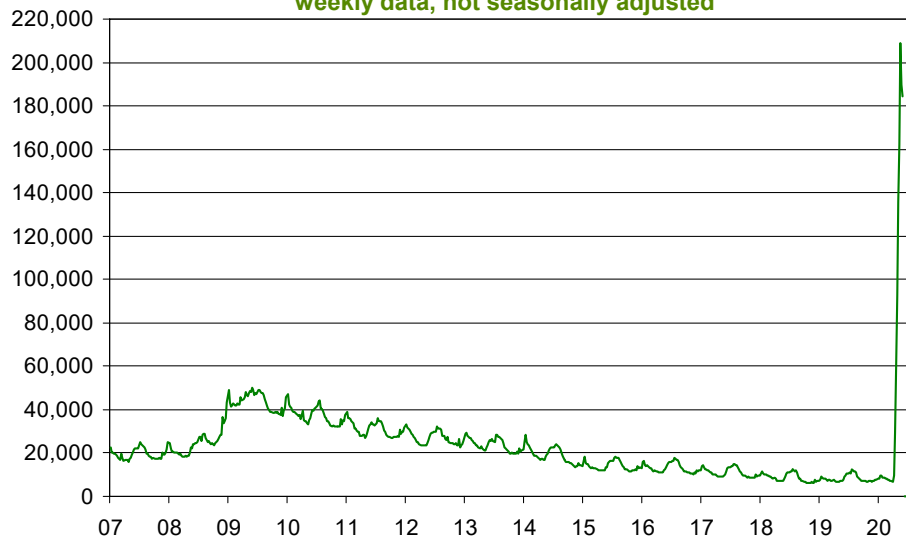

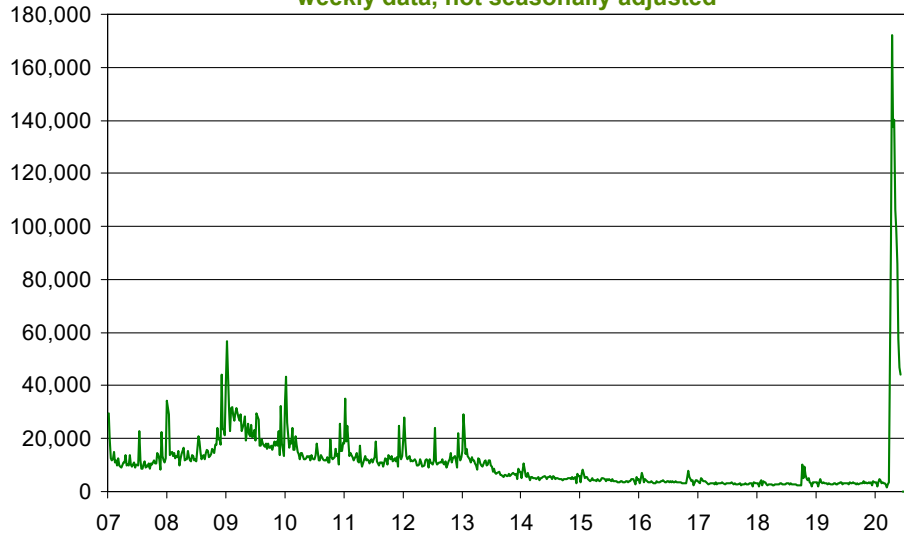

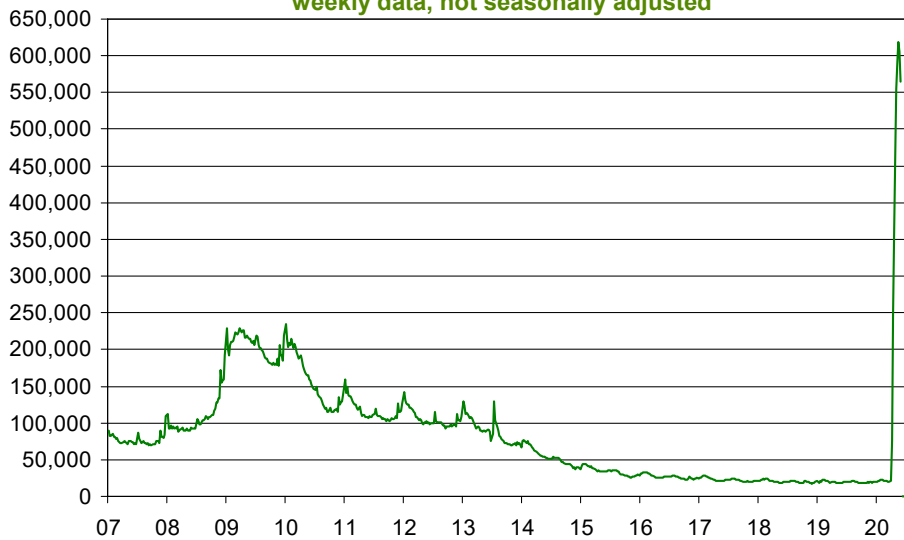

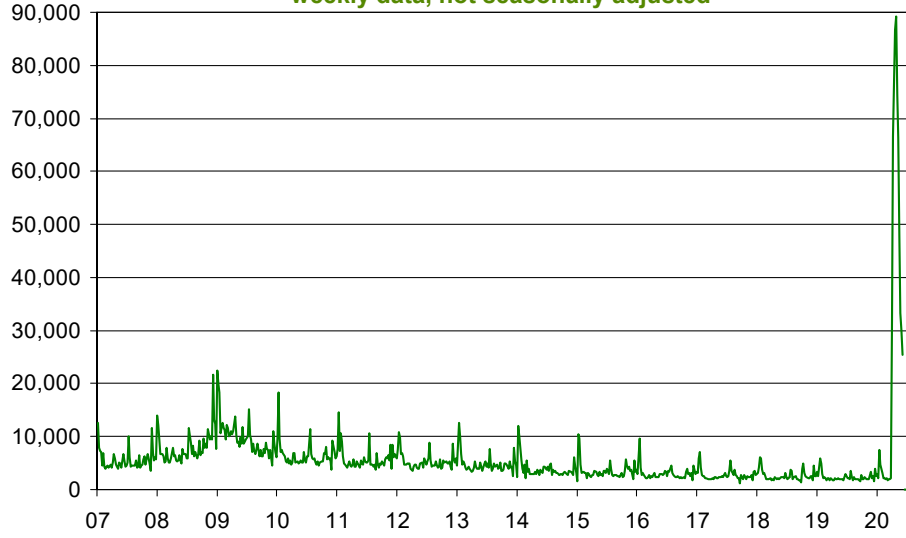

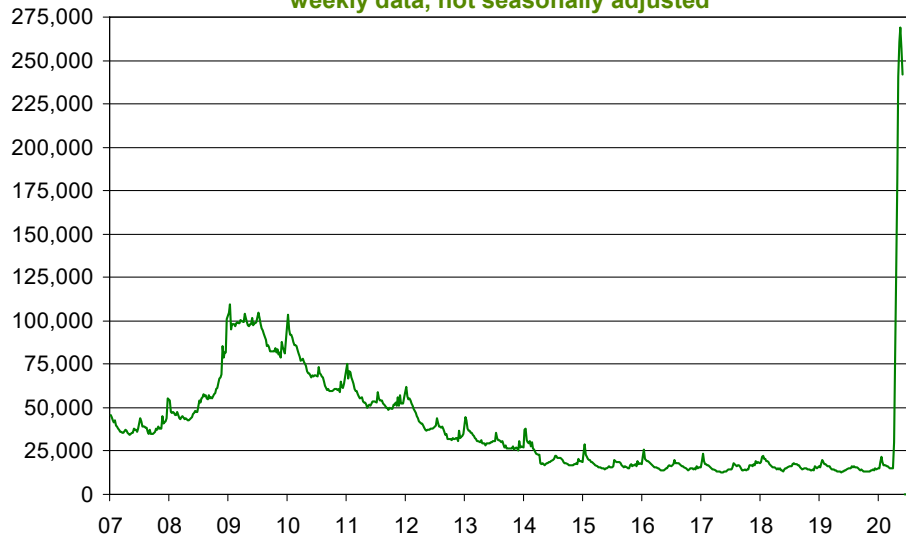

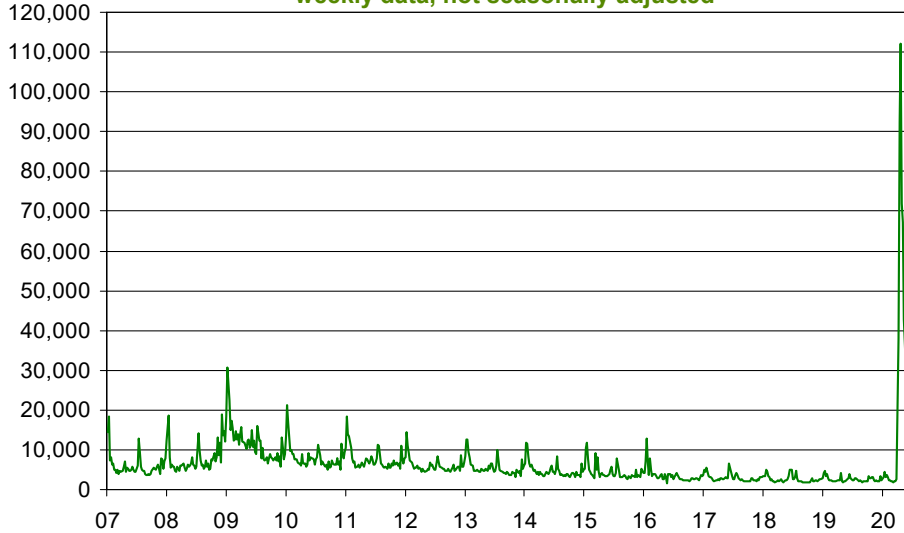

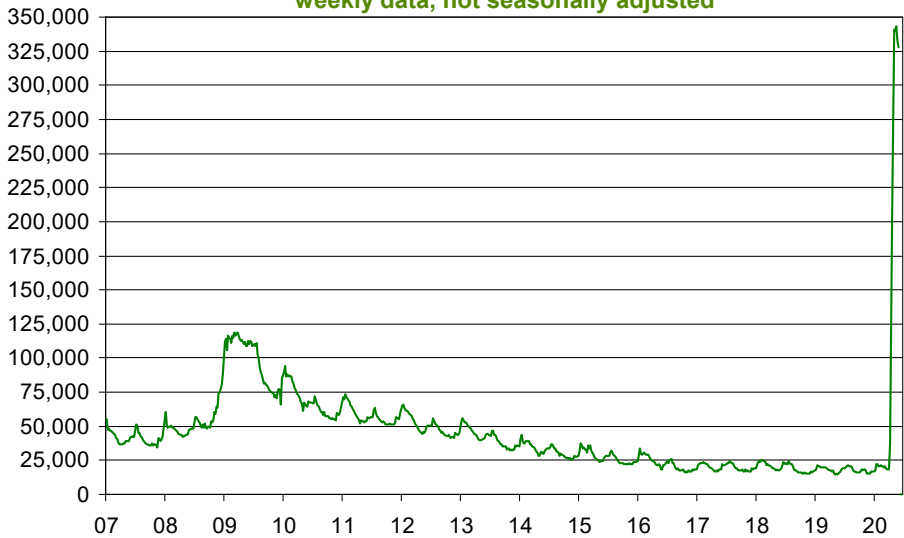

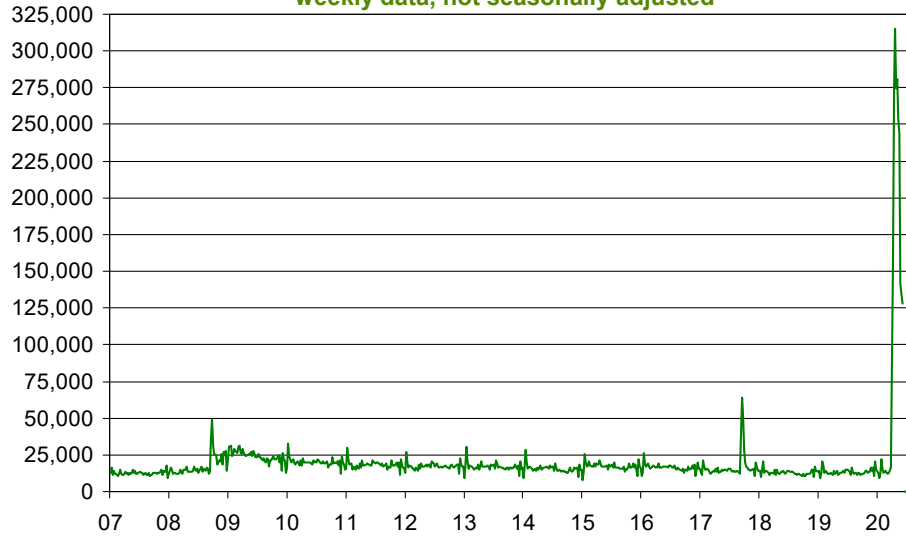

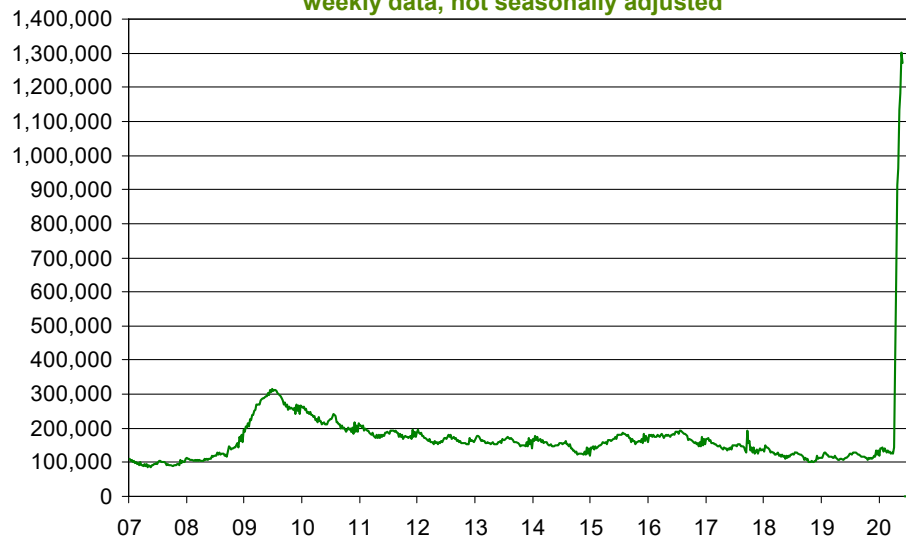

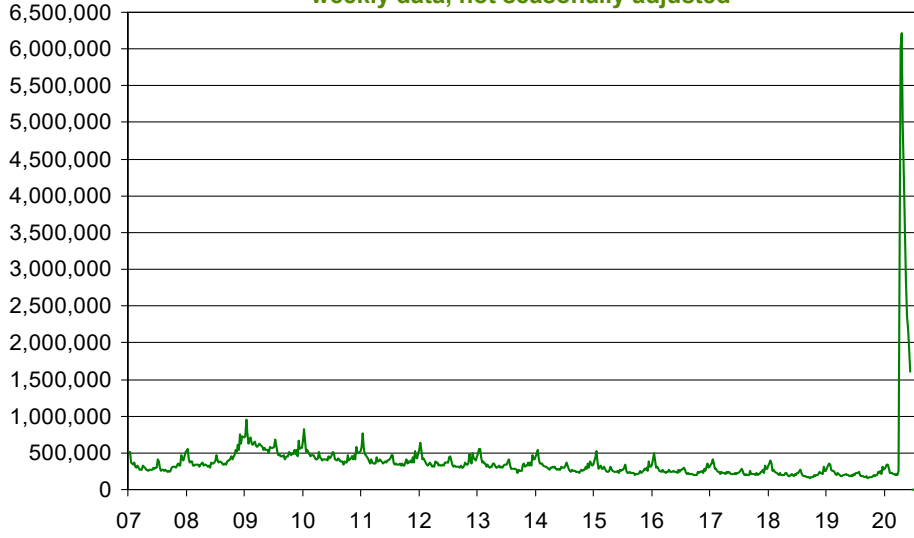

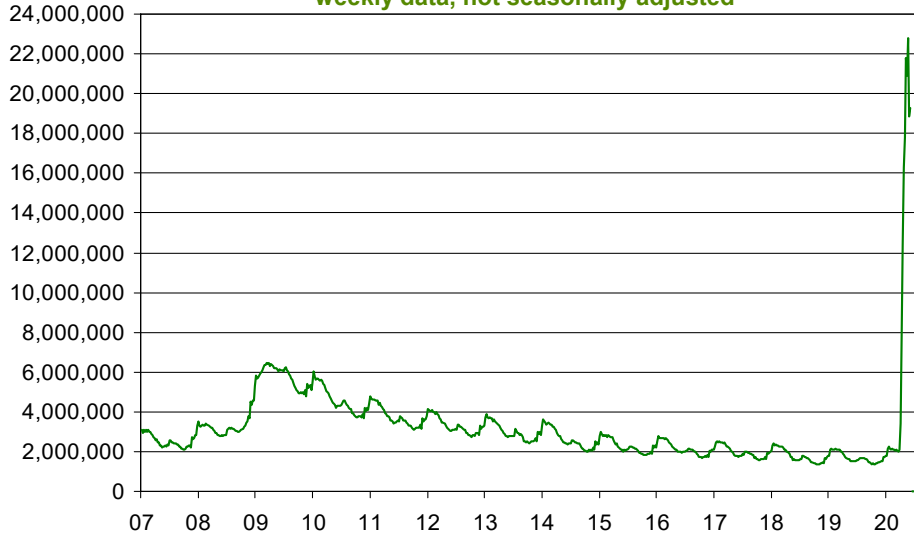
