#### VO from Chase Chapman

Hi, I'm Chase Chapman with Regions Bank Entertainment and Sports Division. Here with me this morning is singer-songwriter and friend, Clint Daniels. Clint, thanks for joining me this morning.

So through your history of writing number one hits, you've been in this town for a while. What helps you stay relevant in this ever-evolving industry?

#### VO from Clint Daniels

I think just persistence, you know. I think not giving up on yourself, not paying attention to what's going on around you. You know, make your music. Seems to me like over my career, a lot of guys [who] cut my records had fiddles and steel guitars. They were more... I kind of lean toward the traditional thing just because I kind of grew up that way, you know? And I think it's being true to yourself. You know what I mean? That sounds real cliché, but just telling your story. Don't tell someone else's, you know?

#### VO from Chase Chapman

Well, and having known you for a while now, that really speaks to who you are and who everybody in this town knows that you are.

#### VO from Clint Daniels:

Good to know.

#### VO from Chase Chapman:

Your character is certainly well revered in this town.

**VO from Clint Daniels:**

Well, I've had my times, you know?

**VO from Chase Chapman:**

Tell me about that feeling that you get when you first realize that one of your songs that you've written has gone number one. Tell me about your first one, your first number one. What did that feel like? How did, how did you find out?

**VO from Clint Daniels:**

I had just lost a record deal, and it was kind of hard because I was really young and, you know, you think that there's, that was the last opportunity when that happens. And Joe Nichols was a brand-new artist, and I can't tell you... it was a blessing. It was the first record I'd ever had on any... I mean, my first cut was Earl Thomas Conley, which was amazing. And, you know, my first single was Joe, and still to this day, it's the biggest record I have. And Joe has cut like five of my songs, you know? It's like it's been... it's great when someone cuts your song and it's your first number one, but when they come back and cut, they keep cutting your songs, they keep coming back to the well, that's a blessing, you know?
